1st Reconciliation & 1st Eucharist: The Archdiocese of Seattle requires a full year of formal faith formation prior to the immediate year of preparation for the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist, along with regular attendance at Sunday Mass. Formal faith formation includes attending formal religious education classes, a Catholic school education or an approved home schooling program.



Confirmation: The Archdiocese of Seattle requires formal, systematic, ongoing Catholic faith formation *prior to* the immediate year of preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation. Candidates must be in the eleventh grade or 16 years of age at the time they receive Confirmation. In 2017-18, ninth & tenth grade Catholic youth are enrolled in Year I of the two-year Confirmation program.
