Don't miss Formation! Attend Mass on Sundays & Holy Days of Obligation and at least 20 Sunday classes with your small group each year for both years.

PARISH SERVICE COMMITMENT

Choose a Mass ministry and a Service ministry at Saint Columban. Commit to serve during both years.

LENTEN SACRIFICE - GROUP PROJECT

Together we will prepare to lead the Living Stations of the Cross prayer service and make an act of almsgiving.

MONTHLY YOUTH NIGHTS

Have fun and fellowship together: icebreakers, food, talks, and prayer experiences. Ask questions and live the faith.

RETREAT OR OUTSIDE EXPERIENCE

Get outside your comfort zone. Attend a day-long or weekend retreat or a summer youth conference at least once.

Candidates will attend two years of instruction:
Confirmation Year 1 – fall 2019-spring 2020
Confirmation Year 2 – fall 2020-spring 2021

Candidates who have completed all requirements will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in Winter-Spring 2021. Date TBA.
