Meeting Minutes March 14. 2023

Attendance: Dawn Bauer, Jennifer Langham, Sandy Story, Gaby Makinster, Mary Jo Jenkins

Opening Prayer: Dawn Bauer—Prayer to Padre Pio

Happy Birthday to all those celebrating during the month of March; Karena Peterson, Grace Dvorak & Gerianne Garcia-Laigo.

Treasury Report: Balance is \$ 2,706.76. Income from Fellowship \$102. Expenses for March Fellowship \$ 50.98.

Open positions

The positions of Treasurer and Secretary are open. Until positions are filled: Gaby will act as Treasurer; Jennifer and/or Dawn will fill in as Secretary; Dawn will continue as President.

Circle of Influence

It was agreed the focus should be on monthly events rather than a broader sense to encourage activity; letting women know that if they attend there are NO expectations of volunteerism.

Fall Festival

There will not be an event again this year. However, with the "All hands-on deck", it was a testimony to parishioners pulling together; the women especially shared a closeness those in attendance wish we could go back to.

Yelm Prairie Days:

June 24th, 2023. Gaby suggested increasing food amounts from last year (hot dogs, buns, chips, soda and water). Gaby suggested contacting Darren in K of C for a Chili Cook Off to add to the event; the judge may be someone from KofC or Father Thompson. Increasing advertising outside of the church was discussed but a permit and all its requirements would be needed so decided against it.

Kitchen Supplies:

John Scotto discussed with Dawn that the K of C would cover most of the costs of dry kitchen products (cups, plates, gloves, napkins, plastic utensils) because the K of C can provide up to \$ 300 a year.

Easter Egg Hunt

Cost to D of M \$ 343.24. It was brought up that it appeared every other year the cost was covered by either the K of C or the D of M. Maybe next year approach K of C to cover costs.
