2025 Spring Bazaar & Outdoor Sale

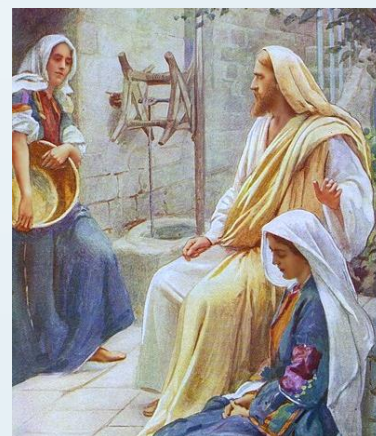
